

## GAZİ UNIVERSITY CRITERIA TO PASS THE TURKISH PREPARATORY COURSE

## Gazi TÖMER:

The Turkish language level of the applicants is determined by the Turkish Proficiency Exam conducted by the university before the beginning of the academic year.

The candidate whose Turkish language proficiency is at C1 level, the candidate who does not have Turkish proficiency is registered to TÖMER.

Students who successfully complete a one-year Turkish course in TÖMER and pass the Turkish Proficiency Exam start their education in the program they are accepted.

After one year of education, students who fail the Turkish Proficiency Exam are given an additional period of one year. The course fee of the student who is registered to TÖMER is not included in the tuition fee.

Students who come to the programs with a foreign language are obliged to certify that their Turkish qualifications are at B1 level within two years.

## Yunus Emre Institute Turkish Proficiency Exam:

This exam is conducted in two sessions: "reading", "listening and writing":

1st session lasts 165 minutes in total, consisting of reading 60, listening 45, writing 60 minutes,

2nd session, lasts 15 minutes in total, consisting of independent speaking 5, face-to-face communication 10 minutes.

The whole exam lasts 180 minutes.

On condition that at least 50% (12.5 points) of each skill area in the exam that the candidates are successful:

- To candidates, who got between 55-70 points in total, B2 level,
- To candidates, who got between 71-88, C1 level,
- To candidates, who got between 89-100 points, C2 level

Turkish Proficiency Document is given.
